This year's booths will include robots, wood turning, blacksmithing, do-it-yourself jar crafts, hands-on pottery, wool spinning, map making, folk art and painting, Internet of Things & Embedded Systems, underwater robots, fuel efficient vehicles, homemade video games, knitting, telescopes, and so much more.
